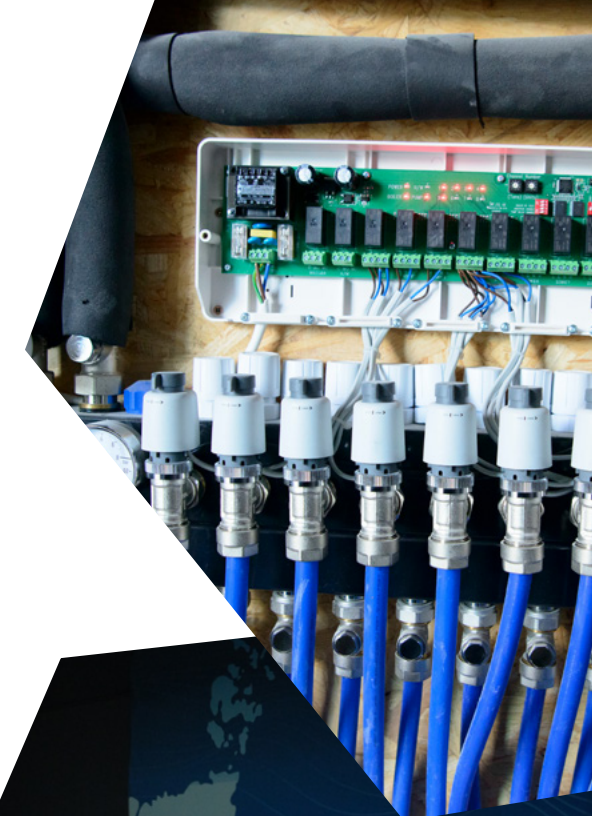

PUBLIC AFFAIRS

Political audiences such as Ministers, MSPs and MPs understand that supporting the renewable energy sector and its supply chain is important and they want to help. Scottish Renewables advocates for our members by guiding politicians on key issues and solutions.

Political successes from our supply chain activities include the announcement of a Green Industrial Strategy and £500 million for the offshore wind supply chain from the Scottish Government, both of which Scottish Renewables continuously campaigned for.

Our public affairs work to represent the Scottish renewable energy sector and supply chain includes:

- Distilling our members views and challenges into campaigns to ensure that politicians understand the needs of the businesses in Scotland
- Ensuring our members are represented to UK and Scottish political parties by responding to parliamentary committee calls for evidence, giving evidence at committee meetings and attending political party conferences



- Including sector priorities in our manifestos and budget submissions ahead of political events, such as Scottish and UK Parliament elections, to ensure political parties can reflect industry views in their own manifestos and governments can take action towards suitable solutions
- Providing a platform for our members to meet with Ministers and MSPs, through hosting roundtables, breakfast briefings, political visits, parliamentary receptions and our annual Supply Chain Dinner, to ensure they are well informed about the needs of the renewable energy sector
